CONSTITUTION

ARTICLE I: NAME

The name of the organization shall be: The Washington Association for Career Counseling and Employment Readiness and is a subsection of the Washington Association for Career and Technical Education.

ARTICLE II: PURPOSE

The purpose of the Washington Association for Career Counseling and Employment Readiness shall be to promote and recognize Career Choices and Work-Site Learning, Career and College Readiness, Jobs for Washington Graduates as integral and important to the total education program in the State of Washington; to work with other organizations to provide professional development in the alignment of CTE standards in programs through in-service activities; to pledge active assistance and support to all members of this organization.

ARTICLE III: MEMBERS

- A. To be eligible for membership in the Washington Association for Career Counseling and Employment Readiness; a person shall be engaged or interested in Career Choices, Work-Site Learning, Jobs for Washington Graduates, and/or Career Counseling/Career Readiness or related course.
- B. All members shall have the right to vote and hold office in the Washington Association for Career Counseling and Employment Readiness
- C. All WA-CCER Board members shall maintain current WA-CCER and WA-ACTE membership.

ARTICLE IV: EXECUTIVE OFFICERS

Officers shall include President, President-Elect, Past President, Secretary and Treasurer.

ARTICLE V: PARLIAMENTARY AUTHORITY

Robert's Rules of Order, Newly Revised shall govern the proceedings of the Washington Association for Career Counseling and Employment Readiness members.

ARTICLE VI: AMENDMENTS

- A. This constitution may be amended by a two-thirds vote of the active membership present at the annual summer meeting provided that members are informed of the constitutional changes ten-days prior to the meeting.
- B. All proposed changes to the constitution must first come before and be approved by the WA-CCER Board Members.

ARTICLE VII: DISSOLUTION

If the Association ceases operating as a functioning Association, as determined by the officers and/or members remaining at the time of dissolution, all assets shall be donated to WA-ACTE.
